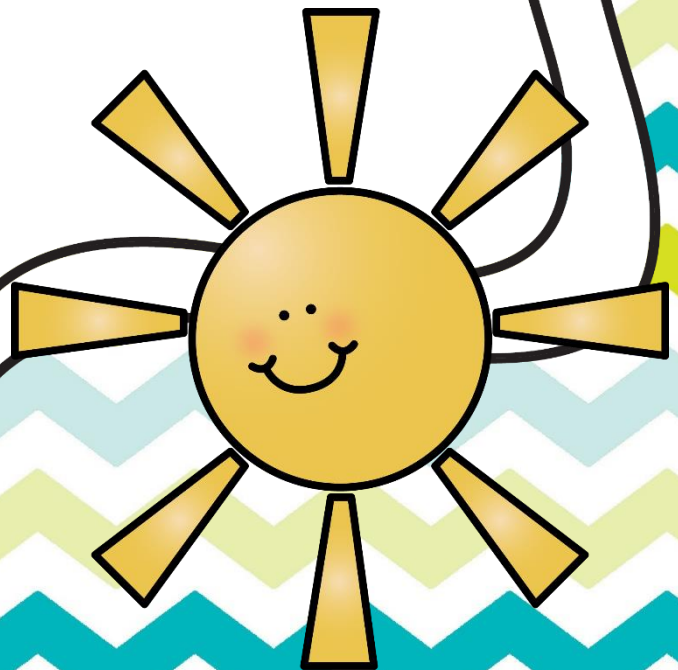


Cloud In A Jar

Cloud In A Jar

Materials Needed:

Clear Cup or Mason Jar

Water

Shaving Cream

Blue Food Coloring

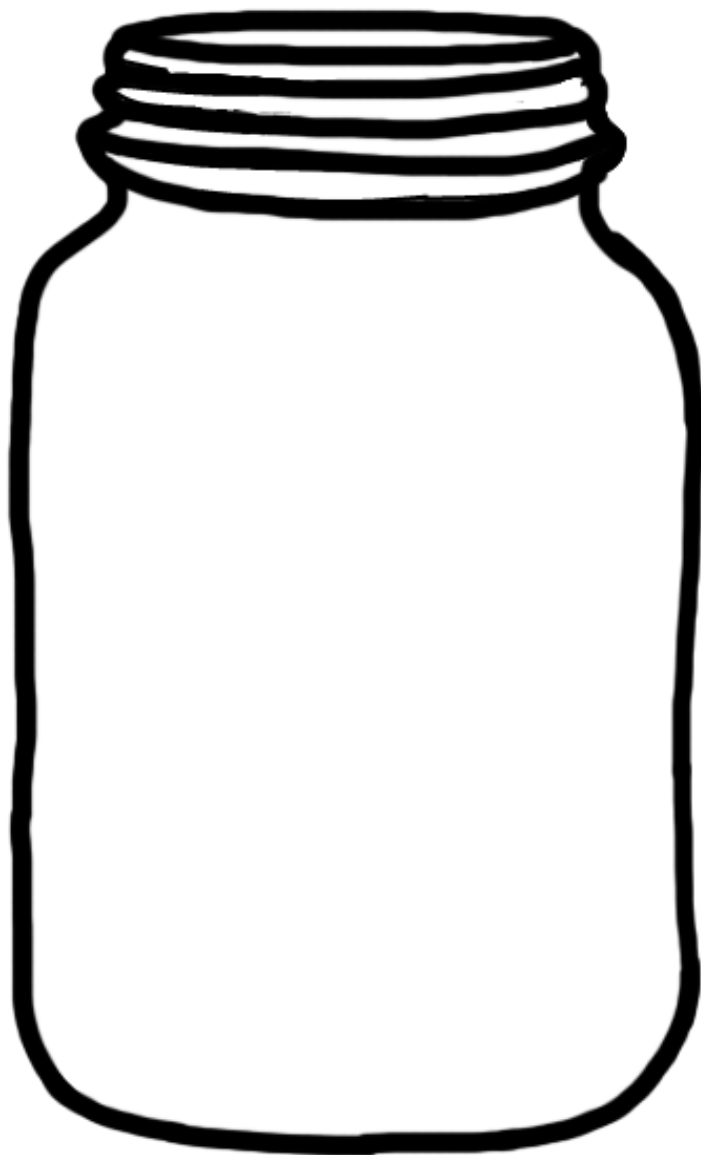
Dropper

Beginning Instruction:

1. With help from an adult, add shaving cream to cover the whole top opening of your jar or cup
2. Add enough blue food coloring to water to make it dark blue, this is your rain.

Before you add any rain to your cloud draw a picture of what it looks like.

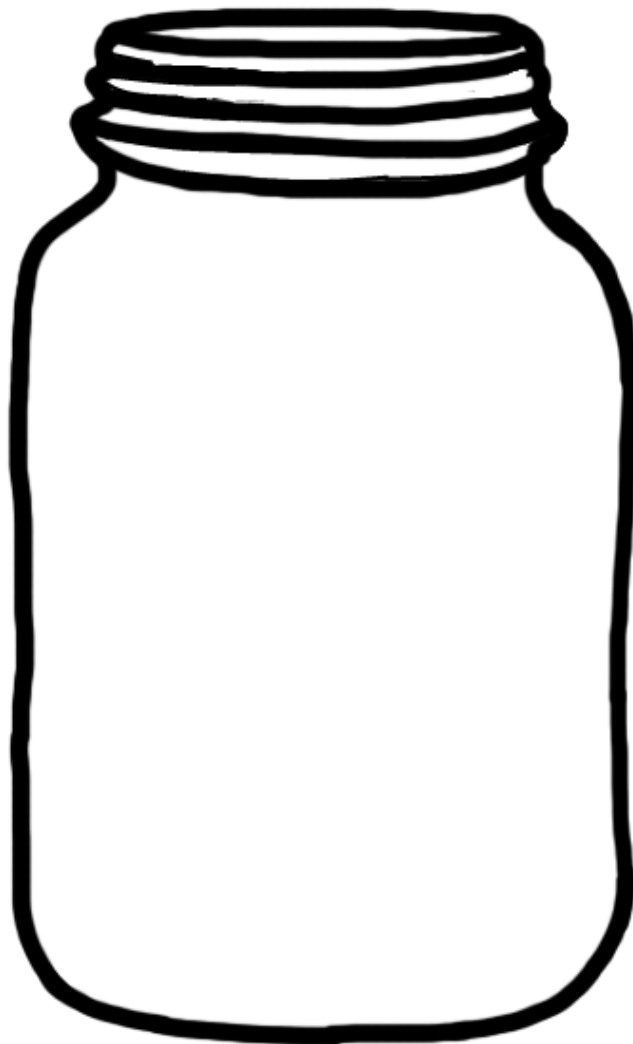


Cloud In A Jar

Take your dropper and add lots of drops of rain on top of the cloud.

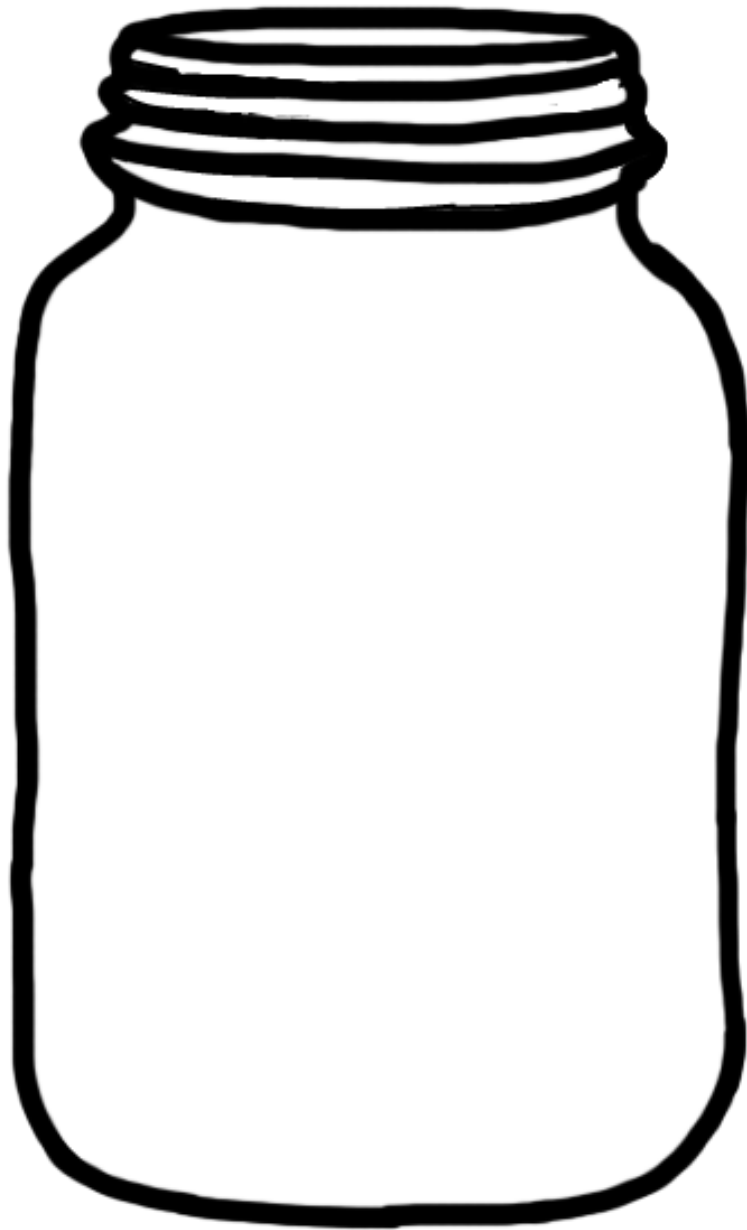
What does it look like?

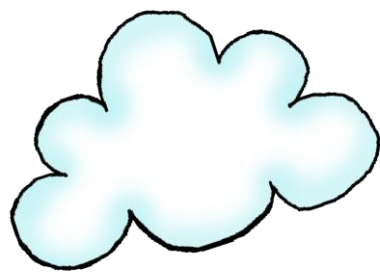
