





I live in the ocean, the largest body of water on earth. There is no air under water so I have to use my scuba gear to breathe. I love to look at the fish and explore.









There is so much snow and ice here! The animals have to learn how to adapt and live in this cold weather.



<u>In the Desert</u>




Many plants and animals can live in the desert if they know how to find and store water without wasting it.




<u>In the Rainforest</u>



My home is very warm and gets lots of rain year round. It is home to millions of different types of animals and plants.




The plants in the rainforest are important to the world, helping make air for us to breathe.




<u>By a Pond</u>
